Q&A

1. Regarding the format in which proposals must be submitted, are we (Vendors/Bidders) required to submit our replies using the exact Excel spreadsheet form that has been provided, or can we take those questions and transfer them to our own proposal document to submit replies, which may be in Word format? **Yes, vendors are required to respond to the Response Requirements in the Excel format provided. That will aid the committee with the capability of performing a side-by-side comparison of all the bid responses.**
2. As it relates to the Broward Health locations that are included in this Bid, please clarify if this bid includes providing services to ALL of Broward Health's hospitals, satellite facilities, primary care clinics, and physician offices, or is this Bid limited to providing services to only the Broward Health hospitals listed within the RFP introduction? **Service will only be provided to the hospitals.**
3. Will Broward Health provide Vendors/Bidders with any previous inventory listings that may exist to assist with the new Vendor's inventory process once the RFP Bid has been awarded? **Yes.**
4. Who are the final decision makers for this RFP? **The selection committee is comprised of representatives from the Facilities, Nursing, Biomed, and Finance teams.**
5. Do the vendors need to have credentialed technicians to work on Broward Health's beds? **No.**
6. Are new OEM parts a requirement to be used for replacement parts? **No.**
7. Is locating technology part of the RFP? **No.**

8. Will you require a centralized documentation tool to access PM verification or online service history? **Broward Health will require a centralized tool to access PM verification.**
9. What is Broward Health's expectations during the PM? **Vendor is to complete PM as stated in the manufacturers' service manual including such things as mattress inspection, battery replacement, and scale calibration.**
10. Can you please elaborate on what "Other Related Services" means in the Scope of Work? **Items to be considered: overbed tables, nightstands, recliners, etc.**
11. Are you able to provide us with what bed types you may have? **Broward Health has Stryker and Hill-Rom beds.**
12. Will all questions be published to all vendors? **Yes.**
13. Since no inventory is available is it possible to get the majority of the Models or the mix of specialty beds and L&D? **There are significant quantities of Hill-rom Centrella beds, and Stryker 1015 and 1115 stretchers.**
14. If awarded will there be onsite dedicated space for PMs and Repairs at each location? **Yes.**
15. What are the expected hours of operation? **8:00AM-4:30PM**
16. What is the current condition of the beds? **On average the current condition of the beds can be considered to be Fair to Good.**
17. Have the beds had periodic maintenance and PMs performed within the last 12 months? **Yes.**
18. Are any beds under warranty? **Yes.**
19. Was RFP sent out to all vendors or just Vizient members? **The RFP was released to the public.**
