Q&A

1. Is this an “all or nothing” proposal? **Yes, Broward Health is looking to contract with vendor(s) that can provide all the services listed in the Scope of Work. Vendor(s) will be used based on availability of resources and deployment expediency at the time of need.**
2. Is Broward Health going to award the contract to one vendor or several vendors? **The intent is to award to multiple vendors (primary, secondary, etc.) however it is ultimately a decision to be made by the Selection Committee.**
3. If several vendors, how will Broward Health determine which vendor performs what work? **Broward Health will engage selected vendors based on available resources and deployment expediency at the time of need.**
4. What is the name of the current companies under this contract and what are their current bill rates? **Broward Health does not currently have a vendor on contract to provide these services.**
5. Reference financial statements submitted with bid. Can they be marked “Confidential” so they are not available for public record requests? **Please refer to the following sections included in the RFP documents regarding the exemption of these documents from public records requests under the Florida Statutes and how they must be submitted in order to ensure they are not included in any public records requests that may be received. 6. We would like to know how many vendors will be awarded a contract as a result of this RFP. **The intent is to award to multiple vendors (primary, secondary, etc.) however it is ultimately a decision to be made by the Selection Committee.**
7. Under Deliverables, please clarify what it means that “Contractor shall be able to provide knowledge and expertise associated with developing a framework for reconstruction that incorporates resiliency measures to build to a risk-adjusted level? **Broward Health is looking to engage with a vendor(s) knowledgeable enough to provide reconstruction/remedial recommendations to prevent recurrences.**

8. Under Proposed Solution, please explain what it means to “Discuss services provided as to how to “disaster-proof” any remedial actions that will be taken, to avoid incurring the same expense again”? **Broward Health is looking to engage with a vendor(s) knowledgeable enough to provide reconstruction/remedial recommendations to prevent recurrences.**
9. Under Proposed Solution, please explain what it means to “Explain your understanding of the documentation required by FEMA. Provides samples.” **For Federal and State declared disaster events, Broward Health will request reimbursement for expenditures; the selected vendor must be very familiar with disaster documentation required for FEMA reimbursement request.**
10. Reference pricing, page 25 states to provide hourly rates “for all categories of labor to be provided under this RFP.” Is there a list of line items companies are to bid on? **No, vendors are requested to provide their line-item costs.**
11. Under Pricing Proposal, given the length of the Contract period (up to 5 years) and the current inflationary market conditions, how often can rates be updated to properly track the real market inflationary conditions? **The pricing provided should take into consideration any market adjustments that may be necessary.**
12. Please advise on the annual estimated budget for the currently advertised Disaster Mitigation, Recovery and Restoration Services. **Broward Health will not be providing that information at this time.**
